Section III –Waiver & Documentation Requirements

In order to receive the Presidential/Academic Superior Student Waiver, all students **must:**

- Must be enrolled full-time
 - At least 12 credit hours in fall and/or spring. Graduate students 6 credit hours.
 - 6 credit hours for summer all students(optional)
- **Freshmen** (no previous college credit)
 - Must have an SAT (critical reading and mathematics) of 1000 or higher or ACT composite of 21 or higher
 - Must have a high school GPA in **academic** subjects of 2.0 or better.
- **Transfer Students** (students with prior college experience) must meet regular admission requirements for freshmen and have a college GPA of 2.0 or better. **Graduate Students** must meet regular admission requirements and GPA of 3.0 or better.
- Academically exceptional students must work (tutoring, etc.) a designated number of hours per week (minimum of 40 hours per semester) while school is in session.

ALL STUDENTS MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Completed application**
- Essay**
- Proof of lawful presence.**
